About the Play

The Donnellys is based on Canada's most famous vigilante murders. A story from 1880 that has grown in the telling with each generation. The events that shook the little village of Lucan and London, Ontario where the trial was held. The murders caused a sensation around the world.

Each candidate will submit a completed audition form to the stage manager when your name is called. Please arrive ten minutes prior to your audition time slot in order to complete the audition form or download and complete the form prior to arrival. A headshot and/or resume may accompany the audition form.

Each youth candidate will tell/enact - within a time limit of three to five minutes - a fairy tale of choice, playing all the characters (a small bag of props and costume pieces permitted) followed by a vocal range check.

*Little Red Riding Hood

*Hansel & Gretel

Each youth candidate will attend the callback session if notified to do so.
